Postdoctoral position available at the Center of Research in Myology, Paris.

A postdoctoral position is available at the Center of Research in Myology (UMRS 974 Inserm and Sorbonne Université, Institute of Myology, Paris, France). The position will be in the team 'Muscle cell organization and therapy of dominant centronuclear myopathy' headed by Marc Bitoun. The postdoctoral fellow will work on an ANR (Agence Nationale de la Recherche) project entitled "Preclinical development of therapies by modulation of Dynamin 2 expression" aiming at developing a therapeutic approach for centronuclear myopathies in animal models and patient-derived cells.

The ideal candidate is a PhD in muscle pathophysiology and/or therapy. Previous postdoctoral experience is not mandatory. Expertise in muscle histology, animal experimentation and cell culture would be appreciated as well as expertise in classical technics of molecular biology and biochemistry. She/he should be motivated, autonomous, yet willing to work in collaboration with a second team involved in the ANR project.

The work will be performed at the Center of Research in Myology housed at the Institute of Myology (GHU Pitié-Salpêtrière, 75013, Paris, France).
